Position overview:

This internship should offer hands-on experience in assembling, testing, and maintaining equipment, conducting experiments, and assisting in data analysis.

Skills the intern will have:

- **Equipment Testing:** Proficiency in conducting equipment testing, including setup, data collection, and analysis. Ability to troubleshoot and resolve issues during testing.
- **Maintenance, Debugging, and Repair:** Hands-on experience and knowledge in equipment maintenance, debugging, and repair, with a focus on ensuring optimal functionality.
- **Safety, Standardization, and Troubleshooting:** Understanding and adherence to safety protocols, standardization procedures, and the ability to troubleshoot equipment issues to maintain a safe and efficient work environment.
- **Test Plan Knowledge:** Familiarity with test planning processes, including the creation of test plans, test procedures, and data analysis to meet project objectives.

Expectations:

Interns will work with host companies to determine if work will be done virtually or in-person. Internships will be a maximum of 240-hours total beginning in mid-May at the earliest and ending in September at the latest.
